◆ Guided History Walks ◆

The Hereford Guild of Mayor's Guides host small groups on a stroll that takes about one and a half hours around the city centre, imparting historical information and stories.

◆ Ghost Walks ◆ (adults 16+)

The Ghost Tour of Hereford is a spine-tingling walking experience through the city's oldest streets, where history and haunting collide.

◆ Children's Hereford ◆ Horrid History Walks

This walk is a revised version of the adult ghost walk that takes place during the day, educating and entertaining children up to 16 years of age about Hereford's historical past.

◆ Hereford ◆ Cathedral Events

Stunning architecture, the famous Mappa Mundi, Chained Library, family activities and even an escape room. There is so much to see and explore.

◆ Museum of Cider ◆

Learn about the history of Cider and Perry making across Britain as you journey through the original 1888 Bulmer's factory.
